The following materials can be accepted into the VWD landfill.

Construction demolition waste including roofing materials, wall covering, plaster, drywall, gypsum board.

Furniture and carpet that has been in flood or fire.

Yard waste – trees, stumps, shrubs including junipers, leaves, grass clippings and sod. These items cannot be mingled with household waste.

Agricultural waste generated on farms resulting from production of hay, straw, old barns, out building, barbwire, bricks, concrete, masonry materials, rock, lumber and rebar.

Painted or treated boards will be accepted unless it is considered treated with hazardous material.

Industrial wastes including electrical power generation, textile manufacturing, leather and leather products.

Packaging and rubble resulting from construction, remodeling repair and demolition operations.

Dead animals less than 15 pounds.

The following materials cannot be accepted into the VWD landfill:

Tires or Batteries

Household Waste

Electronic Circuits

Hazardous Waste

Paint, Fuel or Oil

Dead Animals over 15 pounds

Treated Lumber (example: railroad ties, or fence posts treated with creosote)

Liquids or Pesticides

Please do not use unopened garbage sacks since we are unable to identify contents.
